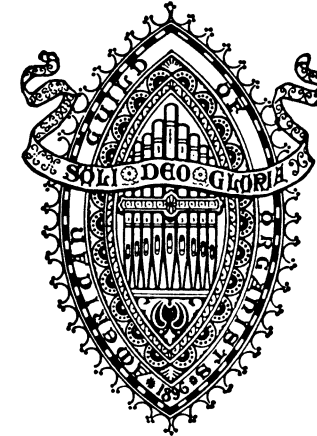

## Joseph Balistreri

Joseph Balistreri, a native of Detroit, Michigan, began organ study with Pierre Toucheque, a student of Flor Peeters and Marcel Dupré. At age 16, Joe was appointed Director of Music at St. Matthew Catholic Church in Detroit, a position he still holds. Joe earned a Bachelor's Degree in Organ at the University of Michigan under Professor James Kibbie. He now is working towards a Masters Degree with Dr. Kibbie. Joe is an avid performer of varied organ repertoire and a passionate improviser. His performances include an AGO convention, university conferences, and orchestral collaborations. The American Organist Magazine has described Joe's playing as "especially moving."

In his spare time, Joe enjoys cycling, cooking, surveying architecture, Detroit politics and composing. Joe is particularly proud of creating the St. Jude Recital Series, a community-building, fundraising series of organ recitals supporting the restoration and upkeep of the 75-rank Pilzecker organ of St. Jude Church, Detroit.
